The Place of TAFE

Advocating the public purpose and value of TAFE.

Promote TAFE as the backbone and quality benchmark of VET in Victoria*. Ensure TAFE is recognised for its role as an economic and social agent for change.

The VTA will represent the sector in dealings with government, industry and community stakeholders.

Thought Leadership

Advocating the role of TAFE as expert partners with government on policy initiatives and development.

TAFEs have knowledge, insight, and lived experience of VET provision to support the development of government policy and to provide advice on reform, governance and innovation.

Harness the collective capacity of the sector, and advocate for TAFE to be partners and co-creators of policy that impact on them and on VET reform.

Innovative Partnerships

With industry, community and government to demonstrate the economic and social impacts of collaboration with TAFE.

Industry has a relationship of mutual benefit with TAFE. Sector-wide employer satisfaction data and individual institute relationships highlight a positive story.

The VTA will assist members to build existing industry relationships into an effective alliance with the TAFE sector.

Partner with TDA on National Issues

Collaborate with TDA to ensure a Victorian perspective is integral in national reform.

Ensure Victorian TAFEs have a voice in and an impact on TDA policy formation, and that a Victorian position is articulated.

Develop policy positions on national reform issues with TDA to highlight the Victorian TAFE perspective.
