The Strategy

- Skills for All aims to create:
- A system that is **simpler to access and navigate**; and
- Supports **more people to enter training, progress** to higher qualifications and employment
- Aligned to the **needs of industry**

The Strategy cont



tafeSA

- **A training subsidy** – South Australians over 16 will be eligible for a government funded training place
- **Client choice** – funding to pre-approved Skills for All providers
- **For Tafe** - Creates opportunities for growth
 - Creates risks from competition
